Program

Denis Commette, K2NPT gave an interesting presentation on the Yaesu Fusion digital voice system and Wires-X which connects the system to the internet to permit worldwide communication. The Yaesu Fusion system uses C4FM to provide digital voice, data, or both. It also supports conventional FM. A Fusion repeater like the one being considered as a replacement for our FM repeater would support the Fusion modes as well as traditional FM analog radio. It has automatic mode select so a person using a traditional FM transceiver can talk to Fusion stations through the repeater. Denis also described Wires-X which is a means of coupling a Fusion repeater to the internet. Several members present already have Fusion radios and are enjoying worldwide communications through various "rooms" available on Wires-X. As a result of this presentation, many more members know more about the Yaesu Fusion system.
