October 16, 2019

Bob reminded the members that there will be a memorial to John, KC2YWL on Saturday, October 26 from 1 to 4 pm. Dress is casual.

Secretary's Report:

In the absence of Secretary John King, KA2F, Bob, W2OD read the minutes of the October 2 meeting prepared by John. A motion was made by Paul, WB2ERY and seconded by Art, W2NAZ to accept the minutes as read. The motion passed unanimously.

There were no known new member applications.

President's Report:

President Art, N2AJO reported that Hudson Division Director Ria Jairam, N2RJ will be our guest speaker at the November 6 meeting.

Art also announced that the November 20 business meeting will be short and the Remote Hams system will be described by members of the team working to make remote operation of our club station available to all GSARA members.

Treasurer's Report:

Treasurer Art Olson reported that our current cash balance is \$7681.18. He gave a detailed breakdown of all expenses and income for the past month. A motion was made by Paul, WB2ERY and seconded by Don, KG2NV to accept the Treasurer's report as read. The motion passed unanimously.

Committee Reports:

Member-of-Year: Bob, W2OD read the report by John, KA2F that thus far, 34 nominations have been received with votes for 10 individual members. Nominations will be accepted until the end of October. The results are being kept private by John.

Dues Vouchers: Denis, K2NPT has proposed that all dues paid for 2020 must be accompanied by a voucher downloadable from the GSARA website. The voucher will show who paid the dues, how much was paid, and whether the member wants a membership card.

Swap & Shop: Denis, K2NPT reported that the GSARA website now has a section where members can list equipment to be bought, sold, or swapped. It is up to the member to remove his listing after the item is bought, sold or swapped.

Remote Ham Program: Denis, N2NPT pointed out the importance of members to attend the November 20 meeting to learn about how to use the Remote Hams software on your home computer to operate the HF station at the Red Cross by remote control through the internet.

New Business:

Denis, K2NPT is getting 8 new plates on the Silent Key Palque engraved with the 8 silent keys of the past two years. A motion was made by Joe, W2KQ and seconded by Mike, N2MEP to authorize \$100 to pay for the engraving. The motion passed unanimously.
